School photography information:

**Online orders** - do not require an envelope returned to your school

**Sibling photos** - Don't forget to pre-order your sibling photos online up to 24 hours before photo day. Advanced Life provide the school with a list of sibling orders right up to the day of photography, so no one misses out. If you miss the online order deadline, you can submit a completed sibling order envelope first thing in the morning of the day of photography, so the school is aware you want the photo taken and can bring your children together in time for it. Sibling photographs only apply to children enrolled at the school.

**Late fees** - a late fee will be applied to each package purchased after photo day due to the additional cost of producing these packages separately

**Package delivery** - School photographs will be returned approximately 6 weeks after the day of photography. Please note this delivery timeframe is dependent on proofing and additional photography days at your school.

**Previous years' photos** - Past years' photographs including sports, co-curricular and representative groups are also available to order under the "previous years or group photo" tabs at the advancedorder site when you click on the "Order School Photos Here" button. You can also order past packages, portrait images and gifts from your child's unique, individual and secure **advancedyou** image archive site using the unique 9 digit image code found on packages you have ordered in the past
